The Grand Jury Charges:

Count One

[21 U.S.C. § 846]

On or about November 19, 2012, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

ANTHONY PAREDEZ-JUAREZ,
GEORGE JACOB COSME-BAIRD,

and others, aiding and abetting one another, knowingly did attempt to possess with intent to distribute 100 kilograms or more, but less than 1,000 kilograms of marihuana, a controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

A violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

Count Two

[21 U.S.C. § 860 & 18 U.S.C. § 2]

On or about November 19, 2012, in the Western District of Texas, Defendants,

ANTHONY PAREDEZ-JUAREZ,
GEORGE JACOB COSME-BAIRD,


and others, aiding and abetting one another, knowingly did possess with intent to distribute 100 kilograms or more, but less than 1000 kilograms of marihuana, a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising Presidio High School.

A violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 860, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
